America's Future Proudly Supports The Spirit of America Art Museum's *America's Wall of Honor* "First Light" Ceremony on Veterans Day in Omaha, NE

Englewood, Florida – Nov. 10, 2021 – America's Future, Inc. is proud to support and participate in The Spirit of America Art Museum's *America's Wall of Honor* "First Light" ceremonies on Veteran's Day (Nov. 11, 2020) in Omaha, NE to pay tribute to the service and sacrifice of veterans, those serving in all branches of the military today, and all first responders across the nation.

The event will take place in the studio-workshop where the Wall of Honor is being built at 7:00 p.m., and feature the lighting of 48-inch seals of the Army, Navy, Air Force and Marine Corps on *America's Wall of Honor* – a 55' x 10' memorial monument consisting of nine seals of all the military services, the Presidential Seal, plus original seals for first responders in law enforcement, and fire and rescue. Along with the special lighting ceremony, the event will include a Color Guard,



National Anthem, Pledge of Allegiance, a video presentation, and remarks by America's Future Chair, Lt. General Michael T. Flynn, USA (Ret.). For more information about the day's event, please visit www.AWOHFirstLight.com.

America's Wall of Honor (www.americaswallofhonor.com) was designed and created by memorial artist, Tim Lampros, from hundreds of laser-cut pieces of stainless steel, shaped and welded into several layers, powder-coated for permanent color, and mounted on layers of acrylic glass embedded with LED lighting. Mr. Lampros is an acclaimed artist, well-known for his creation of the *LAPD End of Watch Memorial Wall*.

The Spirit of America Art Museum, under the direction of its founder, Dan Stuenzi, commissioned *America's Wall of Honor* in 2019 as part of its mission to encourage and inspire people of all ages to learn about American traditions, values and patriotism with the goal of uniting America

through art, education and love of country. The massive monument, along with a 1,000-square-foot tractor trailer gallery, divided into areas that represent various genres of art and educational exhibits, will be part of a five-year mobile museum tour across the United States beginning next year. Also planned as part of the traveling national tour, is a second expandable trailer functioning as a special classroom for children and young people called the “American Patriot Education Center.” The Center will focus on teaching the U.S. Constitution and American history, values and ideals, and be available at stops around the country for local school field trips.

Organizers plan to establish a permanent brick-and-mortar location for The Spirit of America Art Museum in Omaha, Nebraska, with the theme “The Art of America in the Heart of America.” To learn more about the national tour and to contribute to the multi-million-dollar project, please visit www.soaam.org.
