**Statement of America's Future upon the death of Major General John K. Singlaub, USA (Ret.),
Emeritus Chairman of the Board of Directors**

It is with deep sadness that America's Future, Inc. has learned of the death of our Emeritus Chair, Major General John (Jack) K. Singlaub, USA (Ret.) on January 29, 2022 at 100 years old. Our sincerest condolences go out to his wife, Joan and his children. General Singlaub was an American warrior-hero whose life of service was dedicated to protecting and preserving freedom and the individual rights of all citizens of the United States of America.

"Jack was a great friend, a tremendous servant to our nation and a true American hero. His humility and kindness are what I'll remember most. An extraordinary man during extraordinary times," said Lt. General Michael T. Flynn, USA (Ret.) and America's Future Chair of the Board of Directors. "May he rest in peace with the Lord. Our nation and each of us who knew him are better for his amazing life of service."

General Singlaub's bravery and extensive military service dates back to World War II, when he fought behind enemy lines, through to the Korean conflict and later during the Viet Nam War. He is the recipient of multiple awards including the Distinguished Service Medal, Silver Star, the Legion of Merit, the Air Medal, and Bronze Star, and was inducted into the U.S. Army Ranger Hall of Fame in 2006 and made a Distinguished Member of the Special Forces Regiment in 2007. In 2015, the Special Operations Association recognized General Singlaub's service by creating The MG John K. Singlaub/Jedburgh Award to honor his "courageous actions on and off the battlefield as well as his significant contributions to the U.S. Army Special Operations Forces."

America's Future joins the Singlaub family in remembering his extraordinary lifetime achievements on behalf of America. He was a legend among men, a true friend, a soldiers' soldier, a trusted leader and a man of principles, character and convictions.
